

Church Beyond Walls

During the week of June 27, high school youth teamed up with a handful of our local mission partners to make a difference in our own neighborhoods! After helping out in the community, students returned to the church to share meals, worship together with a guest speaker, and enjoyed nightly events!

To kick off the week, Trinity Youth partnered with Congregational Life to sponsor the “Trinity Serves Beyond Church Walls” event where more than 70 Trinity children, youth, and adults prayed, ate lunch, and worked alongside each other.

During the afternoon event, volunteers packed 400 bags of food representing 4000 breakfast meals for seniors in our community experiencing hunger. Trinity also packed 75 sports hydration bags for Agape summer campers.

We can't begin to count the number of church windows washed inside and out by our Trinity volunteers. Teams of Trinity members also cut back ivy, bagged yard debris, and cleaned up our trails.
